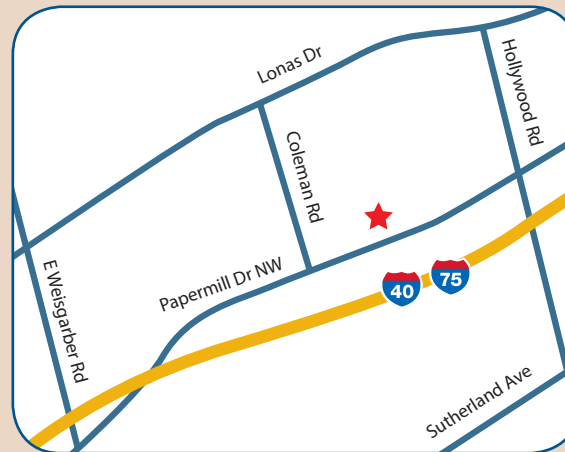

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Effective Treatments for Lasting Comfort

Have you put off seeking treatment for hemorrhoids because of concerns about painful surgery and a long recovery period? At Premier you can take comfort in our expertise. Our non-invasive, non-surgical procedures make hemorrhoid relief quicker, easier and virtually pain-free.

Non-surgical Treatments

Infrared Coagulation is the world's leading office treatment for hemorrhoids. It involves using a small probe that exposes the vein above the hemorrhoid to short bursts of warm light, causing the hemorrhoid to shrink and recede. The area usually heals within one to two weeks.

Banding involves placing elastic bands around the base of the hemorrhoid, cutting off its blood supply and causing it to wither away within a few days.

Non-surgical treatment benefits include:

- Less invasive than traditional methods
- Short treatment times, usually from 15 minutes to one hour
- No downtime
- No anesthesia
- No cutting or stitches

Surgical Treatment

Hemorrhoidectomy may be required for more severe cases.

We will work with you to determine the best treatment option.

Hemorrhoids are common in both men and women. In fact, about half the population has hemorrhoids by age 50. Many pregnant women also suffer from hemorrhoids due to the pressure of the fetus on the abdomen and hormonal changes. When caused by pregnancy, it is often only a temporary problem.

How do I know if I have hemorrhoids?

Symptoms often begin with painless rectal bleeding during bowel movements. Other symptoms can include pain or a burning sensation, protrusion of tissue around the anus and itching.

When should I seek treatment?

As a general rule, consult your doctor if: you are over age 40 or have a family history of colon cancer; your hemorrhoids don't improve with self-care; you have pain or bleed frequently or excessively; you develop bleeding between bowel movements; and/or the onset of your hemorrhoids occurs along with a marked change in bowel habits.

What treatment plan is best for me?

After your exam and any diagnostic tests, your doctor will discuss treatment options with you. In some cases, making simple changes in your diet and bowel habits can resolve the problem. In others, infrared coagulation or banding is recommended. For more serious cases, surgical treatment is required.

Will I have to miss work or limit my activities?

In most cases, you can leave our office and resume your usual activities, with no disruption to your lifestyle.

Will insurance cover my treatment?

Hemorrhoid procedures are normally covered by most insurance plans. Our staff is happy to assist you with any questions regarding coverage.
